This year Camp AREV celebrated its 40-year anniversary. Through the decades, its ministry has thrived for two reasons. First, it has been true to its founding mission: reaching our Armenian community with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Camp AREV has held true to its purpose, which is to help people establish a personal relationship with Jesus, walk in the path of righteousness, and truly live out our Armenian Christian identity.

Second, God continues to provide a great harvest. We just concluded a very successful year in camping ministry. Many first-timers enjoyed Camp AREV's summer and winter programs, delicious food, and opportunities to create friendships and memories for a lifetime. I can confidently say that God was present in our midst, the Spirit was truly working in the heart of every camper.

I can't help but think of Jesus' heart as he looked at the crowd in Matthew 9: 35-38. When our hearts feel the same compassion as that of Christ, the Spirit naturally moves us to become prayer warriors and laborers in this massive harvest.

This year, summer camp was jam packed. We had a record breaking year: we sold out two out of the three weeks. Including counselors and staff

we had close to 160 youth for Junior High camp, and more than 155 for High School camp. We also broke the record for our Juniors camp. With counselors and staff we have close to 100 youth!

God continues to change lives at Camp AREV. We heard so many campers' stories, witnessing how God is transforming the lives of these young people and bringing them closer to Himself.

This year was amazing for fun and activities as well. We introduced our brand-new paintball course, which was a huge success for all ages. We brought back "CLUB SHED" which is our snack shop/gift shop.

We thank God specifically for all the parents, counselors, and staff. I also thank God for the Camp AREV Committee, the AEUNA, and the AMAA for their ongoing prayers and financial support. Their partnership is extremely vital for this ministry.

The harvest is massive, the laborers are few, I ask that we join together in asking the Lord of this harvest to send laborers. All for his glory!



2017 CAMPING PROGRAMS



2017 FACILITY USE




2016 INCOME

My experience last summer was incredible. Many campers that wanted nothing to do with this whole church camp thing were introduced to God for the first time, and we at camp saw a great need for additional strong and mature workers to join the harvest! But God, being God and working in ways nobody expects, revealed himself to these campers. It was

especially great to see the transformation of the counselors throughout each week. Each week many of them started off unsure about how they would relate to their campers, or what to expect. By the end of each week, almost every counselor had amazing stories to share about how God gave them the opportunities to share the gospel and invite their

campers to church. All those struggling at the beginning of the week, suddenly were getting along and confiding in one another! Amazing, isn't it?

In addition to watching God work in the lives of others at camp, I think it was no accident that I decided to be a CO last summer. I just turned 30. I'm sure, like many young Christian adults out there, it can be difficult to be in community with other believers around my age. I

confess that in part I decided to go to camp because I knew that meaningful community was exactly what was missing in my life. The lack of community really took a toll on my relationship with God. Somehow, I knew that camp would provide. That's exactly what camp did for me.

There is so much more to share about

my experience at camp, but at this point I will simply encourage you all to come to camp. We are in desperate need of quality and mature counselors, especially in the young adult age group (about 21 and up). I know it can be difficult with jobs, internships, kids, etc. but I urge you to consider serving for a week/ weekend. Youth leaders and helpers, bring your kids and go to camp as a family. Our campers

need to see examples of Christians that they can look up to and go to for guidance. We can't remain in Christ without other Christians. We just can't.

I want to thank everyone who has been involved with camp. Your prayers, donations, and time serving have been for an amazing cause. Let us continue to share the good news to a world that desperately needs to hear it.
